Working field: The key competences of the subject area are architectural design and building construction, as well as research in the field of concepts and phenomena in architectural design and practice. The chair teaches basic architectural design to first and second semester students in the Bachelor program and supervises Bachelor and Master theses. The main focus is on design concepts with emphasis on their typological, structural, material and socio-spatial implications. The joint education of design and building construction is a unique characteristic of the TU Berlin and constitutes a core element of the "Berlin model of education" to which the Institute for Architecture is committed.

Requirements: Fulfilment of the requirements for assignment acc. to § 113 in conjunction with § 100 BerlHG (Berlin Higher Education Act). Special pedagogic-didactic suitability (direct access 144242) shall be proven by a teaching portfolio. TU Berlin is looking for a female or male architect with professional experience in architecture and didactical skills proven by a minimum of three years of teaching experience at university level in the field of architectural design. A high willingness to cooperate in interdisciplinary teams regarding teaching and research and readiness to collaborate in the academic self-administration and in the various teaching obligations within the Institute for Architecture is expected. Classes are to be held in German, but applicants are also expected to be able to teach courses in English.

Technische Universität Berlin strives to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching and therefore strongly encourages qualified female researchers to apply. Qualified individuals with disabilities will be favored.
